

### THE LESSON OF THE PARABLE... Mt 18:35

- a. "So My heavenly Father also will do to you if each of you, from his heart, does not forgive his brother his trespasses."
- b. Failure to forgive a brother will bring severe punishment!
- **QUESTION:** Why is it difficult to FORGIVE?
